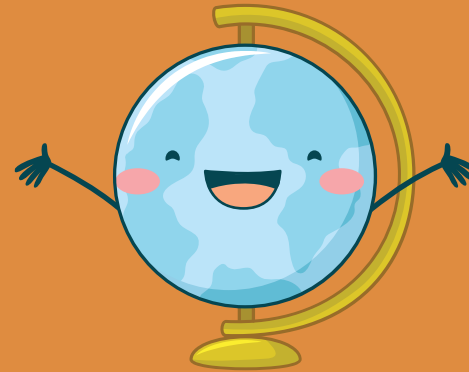
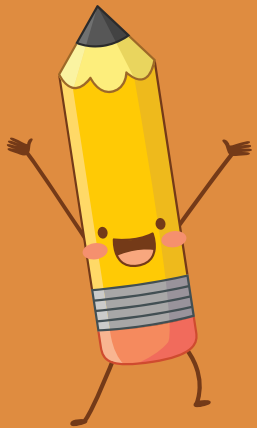

**We follow the National Curriculum.**

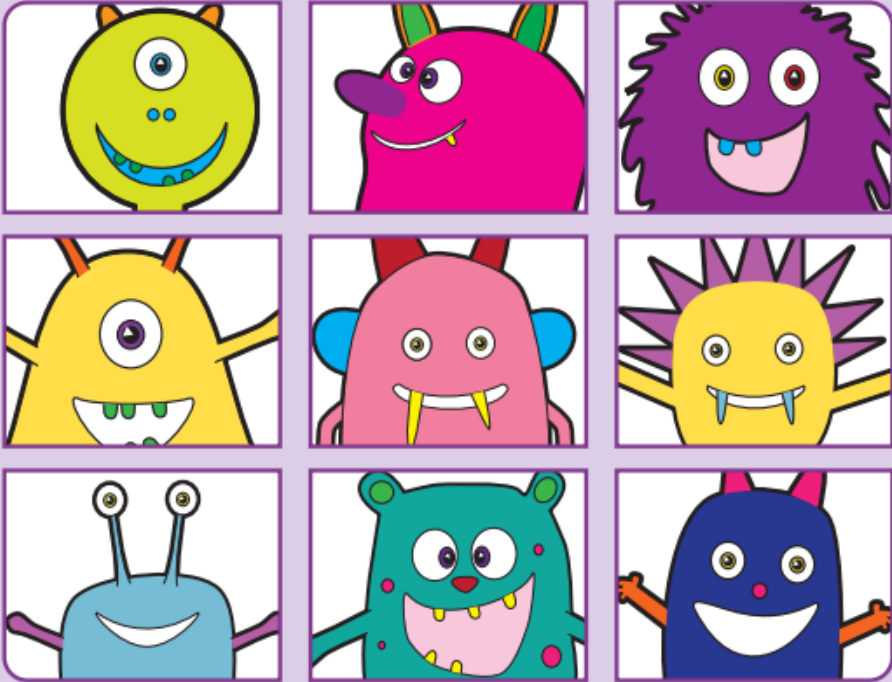
Phonics screening will take place during the month of June. All children must be at school.

**NO HOLIDAYS WILL BE AUTHORISED**

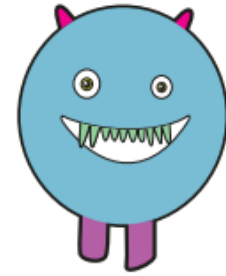

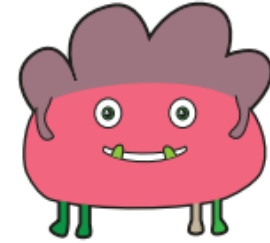

# Reading and Phonics



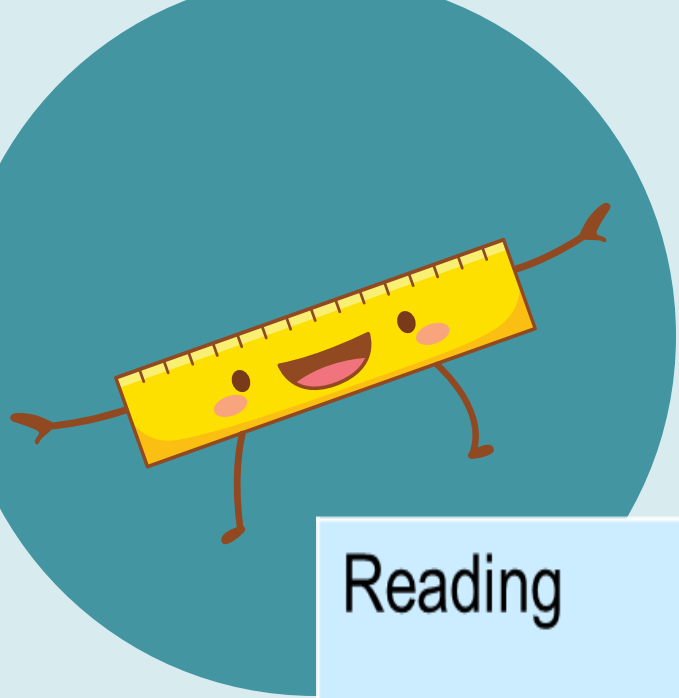
Please encourage reading as often as possible. Children are encouraged to read every day.

Please continue to write in your child's reading record book and include any books that your child reads that are from your collection at home or the local library.

A school adult will read with your child several times a week and write comments in our school reading records.

# Phonics

At the beginning of your child's reading record there is a list of 'tricky words' and high frequency words; please practise these with your child regularly. These are sight words that need to be learnt. Learning these words will help your children read with fluency.



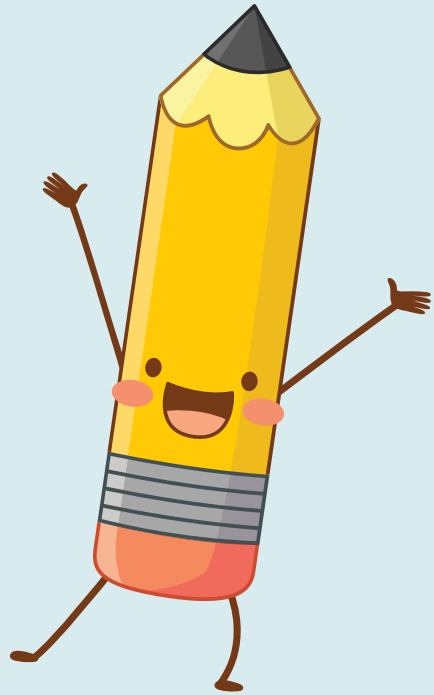
# Helping your child: A summary

Reading	Listen to your child read regularly and write your comments in their reading record. It helps us to understand how they are progressing. Your child can also add the titles of any of their own books that they have read with a short comment about it.
Independence	Let them come into class and settle by themselves.
Confidence	Being prepared and having support at home with their reading

**Do you keep up to date with all that is happening in school?**

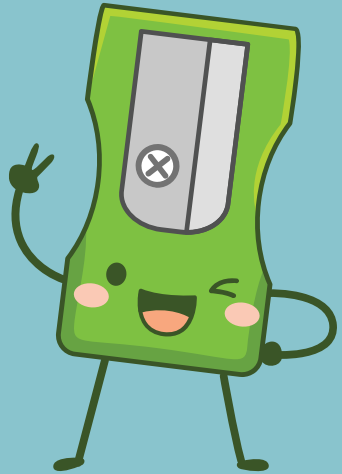
Make sure you are signed up to "Parentmail"
