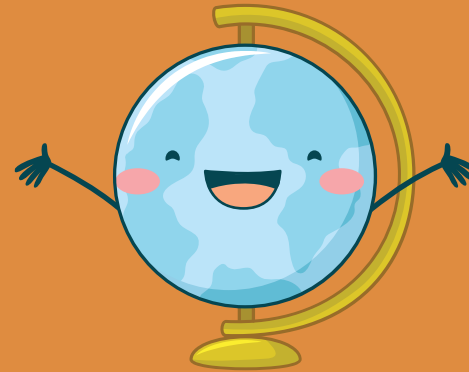
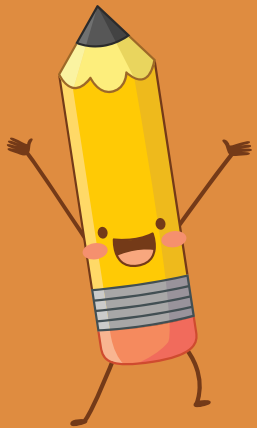

Intervention Groups

If we are concerned about your child's progress, we will speak to you and of course you can approach us if you have any concerns.



Reading

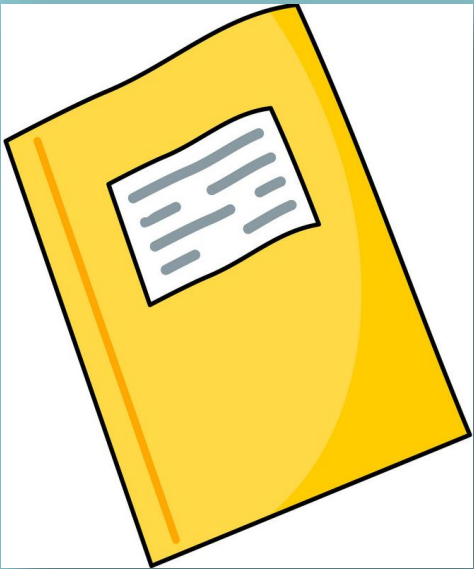
Please encourage reading as often as possible. Children are encouraged to read every evening. In Badger class the children take ownership of their reading books and choose their own book from our school library.



Please continue to write in your child's reading record book and include any books that your child reads that are from your collection at home or the local library. If there are any words that your child struggled with feel free to also note these down.

Badger Class are really excited about the Lucky Readers' Jar! Each morning the children get to add their name into the jar if their reading record has been signed and they are then in for a chance of their name being pulled out in the Friday lucky dip. Three children will win a prize each week.

Homework



In badger class we begin setting homework. These are tasks based on our learning in class.

Each child has received their own yellow homework book which they can cover themselves and decorate in anyway they like. Please make sure that their name is visible and clear on the front of the book.

Homework will be set every two weeks and will be shared in class for everyone to enjoy. This is an opportunity to celebrate the work that the children produce. The best pieces may even be sent to Mrs Underwood for extra recognition of their hard work.

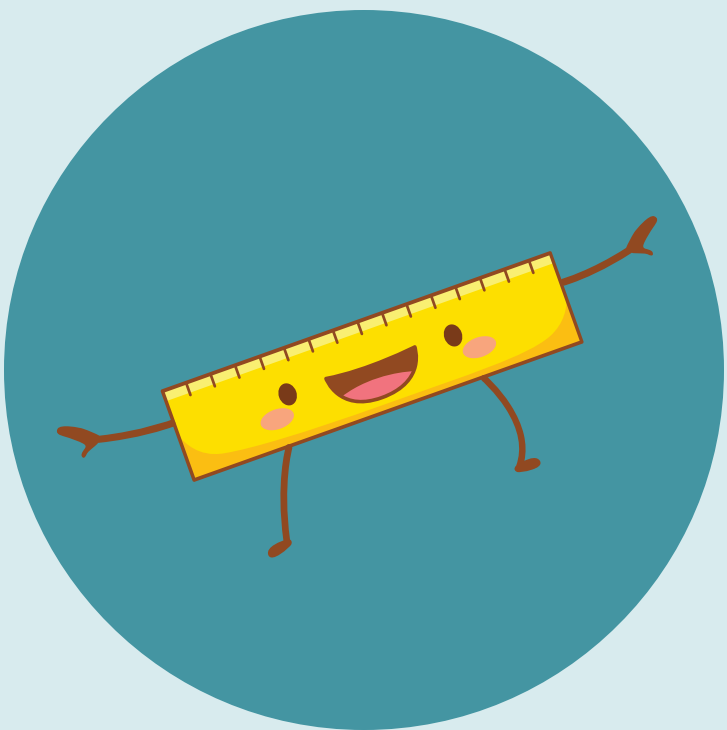
Spelling



Children will also be sent home with a **spelling list** stuck in their reading records each Monday. Please support your child in practising these spelling words at home. Accuracy when spelling becomes more important this year and weekly words are taken from the National Curriculum.

We will have a spelling quiz on these words the following **Monday afternoon**.

Helping your child: A summary



Reading	Listen to your child read regularly and write your comments in their reading record. It helps us to understand how they are progressing. Your child can also add the titles of any of their own books that they have read with a short comment about it.
Independence	Let them come into class and settle by themselves.
Confidence	Being prepared and having support at home with their reading

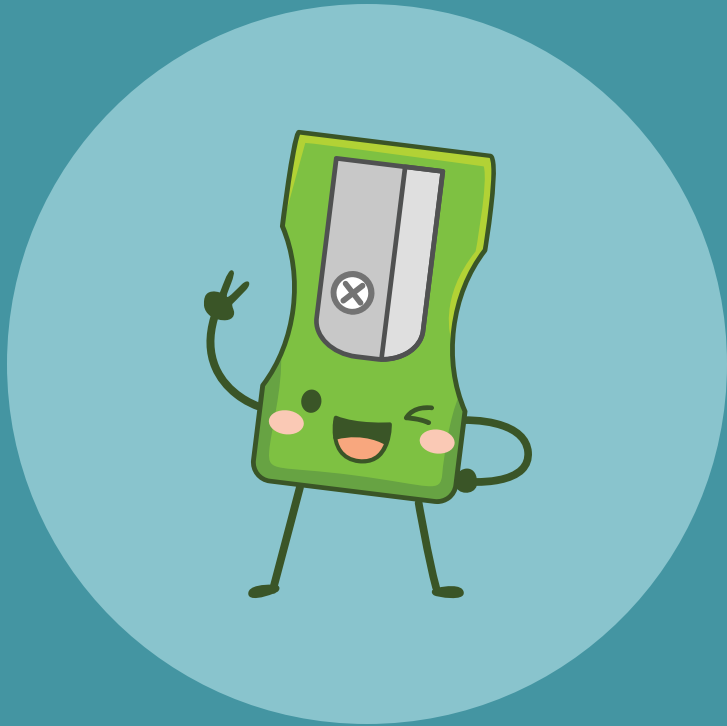
Are you informed?
