English

- Introduction to capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences
- Compose a sentence orally before writing it
- Re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense

- Understanding how the senses work through simple experiments
- Labelling parts of the human body

- What do Christians believe about God?
- The Christian Creation story
- Ways Christians believe God wants them to behave

PSHE & RSE - Being Me in My World

- Rights and responsibilities as a member of my class
- Recognising the choices I make and understanding the consequences

Computing - Purple Mash

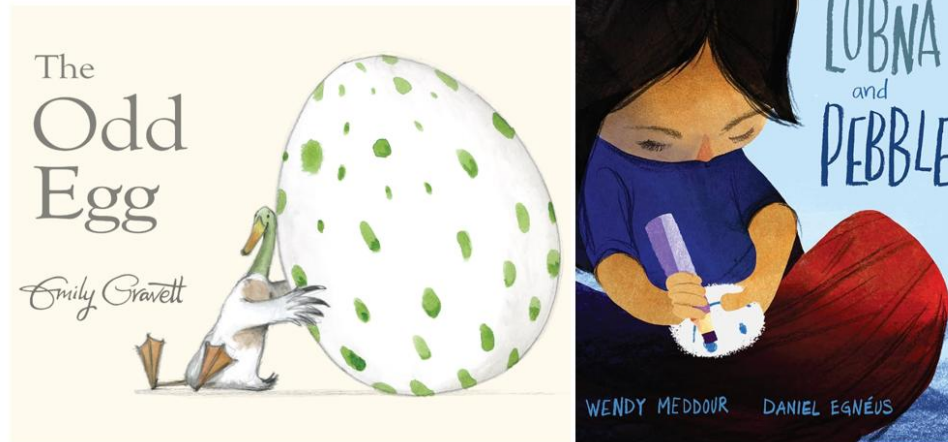
- Online safety
