Upcoming Events:

3rd June 5pm – RSE information evening

All parents and carers are invited to an information session about our RSE curriculum. Relationship and Sex Education is taught in the second half of the summer term. It is part of our PSHE curriculum. Relationships Education and Health Education became statutory in all primary schools in September 2020, as outlined in the DfE's statutory guidance for Relationships, Sex and Health Education. These subjects are a statutory entitlement for all children. This means that whilst we highly value parental views and take these into account when planning and reviewing our curriculum, parents cannot withdraw children from Relationships or Health Education content. However, parents do retain the right to request withdrawal from specific non-statutory Sex Education lessons, which we explain further below. This information evening will support parents to understand the content of the curriculum (particularly in KS2) and provide an opportunity for questions.

5th June – Year 3 sleepover

The year 3 team are looking forward to welcoming some year 3 children for a sleepover in the school hall.

1st July – Sports Day

This will be held at Stepgates' field (in Free Prae Road). Children will start and end their day here and parents and carers will be warmly welcome to join us for a picnic lunch and to support the afternoon activities.

End of day arrangements – We have a duty to safeguard children in our care. An important part of this is considering how to ensure that pupils arrive and leave our premises safely. We would like to remind parents that we are only able to **release children at the end of the day to an adult** unless alternative arrangements have been agreed.

Playtime and afterschool snacks – Many children bring in a snack for breaktime and to eat



before they attend an after-school club. We would like to remind you that these snacks should be a healthy option for example:

- Vegetable sticks – such as celery, cucumber, peppers or carrot, a range of colour ensures different vitamins and minerals.
- A piece of cheddar cheese or babybel
- A piece of fresh or dried fruit (if you are sending grapes these should be halved)
- Cereal bar or healthy homemade snack – e.g. flapjacks or other oat/wholegrain based snack.

These must be nut free. Items brought into school should be carefully checked by you, to ensure this. Meadowcroft has pupils who are severely allergic to a range of nuts.



Lunchbox sweet choice – Please can we also remind you that sweets and chocolate bars are not allowed in lunchboxes or as snacks. Chocolate covered biscuits are a good alternative – if you can buy it in the biscuit aisle it is OK if it is in the sweet section then it is not allowed.

Well done to the children who got an attendance sticker and were celebrated in assembly this morning for their 100% attendance this week. Well done to Beech for being the class with the best attendance.

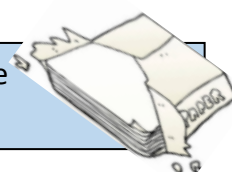

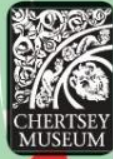
