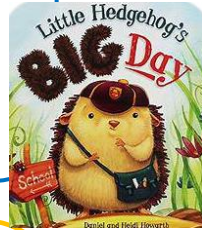


Physical development

Use their core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or sitting on the floor.

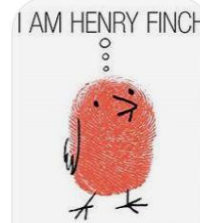
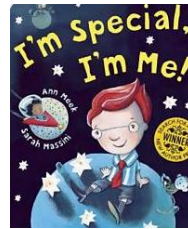
Develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently - Forks, knives, pencil

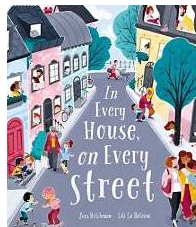
