Topic Content



In year 5, we will be covering a vast range of content in all different subjects. It is important to note that as children reach upper KS2 (Year 5 & 6) this content becomes more mature. We can assure you that everything we teach is appropriate for your child's age, and any sensitive topics are handled with care.

By the end of Year 5, the children will have covered the majority of the English and maths curriculum. When they move up into Year 6, we focus more on depth of knowledge and embedding that information, ready for their SATs at the end of Year 6.

During our changing me topic at the end of this year, our PSHE lessons will cover:

Self and Body Image I am aware of my own self-image and how my body image fits into that.

Puberty for Boys I can describe how boy's bodies change during puberty.

Conception I understand that sexual intercourse can lead to conception and that's how a baby can be made. I understand that sometimes people need help from a doctor to have a baby. (This lesson can be withdrawn from)

Looking Ahead I can think about what I am looking forward to about becoming a teenager.

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School Trips

Mr G and Mrs Fairminer will be working throughout the year to organise school trips for Elm class. Currently in the process of being planned:

- A trip to Botley's mansion during our local history study. This will be followed by a trip to Chertsey Museum to find out all about Botley's and other local establishments for disabled people.
- A trip to White Lodge at the end of our local study in history to see how the way disabled people are viewed and treated has changed.
- A trip to the planetarium in Winston Churchill school during our Earth and Space topic.
