Building a sentence: creating sentences, using full stops, capitals letters and finger spaces.

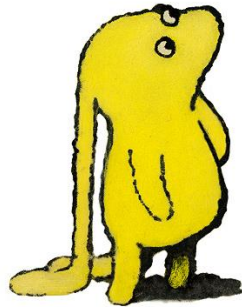
